OVERVIEW OF AGENCIES, BOARDS AND COMMITTEES

Town of Lincoln Public Library Board

The Town of Lincoln Public Library System is a main resource for meeting the lifelong information needs of the citizens of Lincoln.

In accordance with the provisions of the Public Libraries Act of Ontario and Town of Lincoln By-law No. 03-66, as amended, the Council of the Town of Lincoln appoints a Board that is charged with the management, regulation and control of the Libraries in the Town of Lincoln.

The Town of Lincoln Public Library Board consists of a total of 9 members who are appointed by the Council for a term concurrent with that of the Council. More specifically, the Board is comprised of 6 citizen appointees and 3 Members of Town Council. Beginning with the 2006 municipal elections, Library Board members will be appointed to a four (4) year term (ending November 30, 2010). Board Members must be a least 18 years of age, Canadian Citizens, residents of the Town of Lincoln, and not employed by either the Town or the Board.

The Town of Lincoln Library Board meets monthly from September to June in each year. In addition, the Board may establish various committees to deal with specific matters. Meetings may be held at the Moses F. Rittenhouse Library in Vineland or the Fleming Library in Beamsville.
