PRESCRIBING RATES OF SPEED

WHEREAS Section 82 (2) of The Highway Traffic Act authorizes the council of a city, town or village and the trustees of a police village by by-law to prescribe a higher or lower rate of speed for motor vehicles driven on any highway or portion of highway under its jurisdiction than is prescribed providing that such rate of speed shall not be more than 100 kilometres per hour nor less than 40 kilometres per hour;

AND WHEREAS it is deemed expedient that the speed limit for motor vehicles on certain highways in the Municipality of the Town of Lincoln be altered;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the Municipality of the Town of Lincoln enacts as follows:

1. When any highway or portion of highway set out in Columns 1 and 2 of schedule "A" attached hereto is marked in compliance with the regulations of The Highway Traffic Act the maximum rate of speed thereon shall be the rate of speed set out opposite thereto in Column 3.
2. Schedule "B" of By-Law number 1752 of the former Township of Louth is amended by deleting therefrom the words "Third Avenue Louth", together with the references establishing a speed limit on that street in the said by-law.
3. The penalties provided in The Highway Traffic Act shall apply to offences against this by-law.
4. This by-law shall not become effective until approved by the Regional Municipality of Niagara.
