BY-LAW NO. 99-112

A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE EXECUTION OF AN AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF LINCOLN AND CANADIAN TODS LIMITED, FOR THE PLACEMENT OF TOURISM-ORIENTED DIRECTIONAL SIGNAGE WITHIN THE TOWN OF LINCOLN

1. The Council of the Corporation of the Town of Lincoln deems it necessary and expedient to enter into an agreement with Canadian TODS Limited, for the placement of tourism-oriented directional signage on municipal road systems within the Town of Lincoln.


NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF LINCOLN ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

That the Mayor and Clerk be, and they are hereby authorized and directed to execute the agreement between the Corporation of the Town of Lincoln and Canadian TODS Limited, affixed hereto and forming part of this by-law, with respect to the placement of tourism-oriented directional signage, and the Clerk is hereby directed to affix the Corporate Seal thereto.
