

THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF LINCOLN

BY-LAW NO. 00- 112

A BY-LAW TO ESTABLISH THE DATE,  
LOCATION AND TIME OF AN ADVANCE  
VOTE FOR THE 2001 MUNICIPAL  
BY-ELECTION.

WHEREAS:

1. Subsection 43(1) of the Municipal Elections Act 1996, S.O. 1996, Chapter 32 provides that at least thirty days before voting day the Council of a local municipality shall pass a by-law establishing:

- (a) one or more dates for an advance poll; and
- (b) the hours during which voting places shall be open on that date or dates.

2. The Council of the Town of Lincoln for the reasons in Report CS 00-269 deems it necessary and expedient to establish an advance vote for the 2001 Municipal By-Election on Wednesday, January 3, 2001, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.


NOW THEREFORE, THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF LINCOLN HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. That an advance vote for the Town of Lincoln Municipal By-Election be and the same is hereby established on Wednesday, January 3, 2001, between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m., and such advance vote is to be held at the Town of Lincoln Municipal Offices.
