PUBLIC FIREWORKS DISPLAY REQUIREMENTS:

- No person or group of persons may hold a public fireworks display using Display Fireworks, or a public fireworks display using Consumer Fireworks for which a Public Fireworks Display Permit is required under Town of Lincoln By-law 07-77, without first having obtained a Public Fireworks Display Permit issued by the Fire Chief.
- No person other than a Fireworks Supervisor may apply to hold a public fireworks display using Display Fireworks.
- Unless a current site plan is already on file, every application for a Public Fireworks Display Permit must include a detailed site plan depicting the layout and proposed set up of the public fireworks display area, including:
 - (i) the plan scale and a clearly indicated North arrow;
 - (ii) locations of existing structures, public and private access roads, and parking areas;
 - (iii) use of adjacent properties, such as agricultural, woodlands, commercial, residential or other uses;
 - (iv) locations of spectator viewing areas and fireworks discharge areas, and the distance from each discharge area to structures, access roads, parking areas, viewing areas, and adjacent properties.
- Every application for a Public Fireworks Display Permit must be made to the Fire Chief not less than **ten (10) days** before the setting off or holding of the public fireworks display.
- No person may discharge Display Fireworks without first having approved an application for the purchase of Display Fireworks in accordance with the *Explosives Act* and signed by the Authority Having Jurisdiction.
- A Public Fireworks Display Permit is valid only for the specific event for which the application was made, and Display Fireworks may not be discharged except at the times, date, and place specified in the permit.
- No person may discharge any Display Fireworks except in compliance with all conditions and provisions of Town of Lincoln By-law 07-77, the *Explosives Act* and regulations enacted thereunder, and all other applicable legislation.
- Display Fireworks may not be discharged when wind, weather, or other conditions at the time and place of the public fireworks display would pose, or may reasonably be foreseen to pose, a fire hazard or other safety risk to the public.
- The person to whom the Public Fireworks Display Permit was issued must provide and maintain fully operational fire extinguishing equipment ready for immediate use at all times while Display Fireworks are being discharged.
- The person to whom the Public Fireworks Display Permit was issued must be present at all times during the public fireworks display and must supervise the discharge of all Display Fireworks.
- The person to whom the Public Fireworks Display Permit was issued must ensure that all unused fireworks and all fireworks debris are removed and disposed of in an appropriate manner.
- An issued Public Fireworks Display Permit is not transferable to any person, and must be produced forthwith upon demand to any person authorized to enforce Town of Lincoln By-law 07-77.

APPLICATION, RELEASE, AND INDEMNIFICATION AGREEMENT:

By signing below, I hereby acknowledge and agree that I am the applicant specified herein, or a person duly authorized to bind the applicant, and I hereby apply for a Public Fireworks Display Permit and state as follows:

1. I hereby confirm that, to the best of my knowledge, information and belief, the information contained in this application is true and correct.
2. I hereby agree to fully comply with all conditions and requirements of Town of Lincoln By-law 07-77, the *Explosives Act* and all regulations enacted thereunder, and I hereby acknowledge that the contravention of any provision or condition of Town of Lincoln By-law 07-77 is an offence and that a person who is convicted of such an offence will be liable to a fine as provided under the *Provincial Offences Act* for each offence committed.
3. I further hereby acknowledge and agree that any site or place where fireworks are stored or discharged may be inspected, and that the Fire Chief may suspend or revoke, without prior notice or refund of the application fee, any issued Public Fireworks Display Permit where any condition or provision of By-law 07-77 has been contravened.
4. I further hereby acknowledge that I am fully aware of the extraordinary risks involved and hazards associated with a public fireworks display and I voluntarily assume full responsibility for any and all risks of loss, property damage or personal injury whatsoever including death that may be sustained by me or by any other person as a result of the intended fireworks display, whether caused by negligence or otherwise.
5. I further hereby agree to indemnify and save harmless the Town of Lincoln from any and all liability, claims, demands, causes of action, loss, damages, or costs including court costs and legal fees, that the Town of Lincoln may suffer, incur or be liable for resulting from the performance or omission of the applicant with or without negligence on the part of the applicant, the applicant's employees, directors, contractors, or agents.
6. It is my express intent that this waiver of liability and hold harmless release shall bind me and the members of my family and spouse, if I am alive, and my heirs, assigns and personal representatives if I am deceased, and shall be deemed as a release, waiver, discharge and covenant not to sue the Town of Lincoln for any reason whatsoever arising from the issuance of any permit that may be issued from this application.
7. In signing this application, release, and indemnification agreement, I acknowledge and represent that I have read the foregoing, understand it, and sign it voluntarily as my own free act and deed; that no oral representations, statements or inducements, apart for the foregoing written information have been made; that I am at least eighteen (18) years of age and fully competent, and that I execute this application, release, and indemnification agreement for full, adequate and complete consideration fully intending to be bound by same.
