SUBJECT: Decision to shorten the Veto Period for the 2026 Budget

Under the Authority: Part VI.1 (Special Powers and Duties of Head of Council) of the Municipal Act, 2001:

- **Section 284.16 (Veto Powers – Budget Resolutions)**

I, Sandra Easton, Mayor of the Town of Lincoln, acknowledge that the Town of Lincoln Budget Committee considered Report FN-09-25, and approved a resolution at the September 29, 2025, Budget Committee meeting, to shorten the time period for Council amendments to the Mayor's 2026 Proposed Budget to twenty-seven (27) days and shorten the time period for Council to override the head of Council's veto of an amendment to thirteen (13) days.

Now therefore, I, Sandra Easton, Mayor of the Town of Lincoln, hereby issue this decision in accordance with s.7(6) of Ontario Regulation 530/22, to shorten the 10-day period to veto amendment resolutions passed by Town Council to the Mayor's Proposed 2026 Budget to eight (8) days.
